CHARITY BEGINS AT NEW HOME

THESE little hands helped to make a big difference at the unveiling of the 2019 Good Friday Appeal Charity House earlier this week.

Crowds gathered at Henley and Villawood Properties' Delaray community in Clyde North on Wednesday to mark the groundbreaking laying the first slab for the 2019 charity home. Over the past

26 years, the GFA Charity House Auction has raised more than \$14 million for the Royal Children's Hospital.

The vacant 549sq m block is set to be transformed into a stunning four-bedroom home all through the help of dedicated volunteers.

"It's just amazing that so

many people give up their time and work on the property for us," GFA director Anne Randal said.

"The community's personal investment to the hospital is what sets the hospital a part from others."

The 2018 GFA Charity House raked in a record-breaking \$860,000 at auction on Good Friday this year.
